Kinship Carers Liverpool works in partnership with the two Law Clinics in the city based at the University of Liverpool and Liverpool John Moores University Law Schools.

Both offer pro bono/free Family Law Legal Advice sessions and you may be able to access these if eligible. These services are in high demand and usually run term-time only – they are staffed by qualified solicitors volunteering their time, supported by law students.

The University of Liverpool also runs a term time advice clinic for parents or carers of a child with disabilities or long-term illness in relation to access to services and education.
